

Jarmila Zimmermannová

Assoc. prof. Ing. Jarmila Zimmermannová, Ph.D. habilitated at the University of Economics in Prague in 2017 in the field of finance. From 2003 to 2009 she worked in various positions at the Ministry of the Environment of the Czech Republic, most recently as Deputy Director of the Department of Sustainable Energy and Transportation and Head of the Department of Environmental Tax Reform and Transportation. She represented the Ministry of the Environment of the Czech Republic in the

OECD Working Group – Joint Meetings of Tax and Environment Experts. From 2011 to 2022, she worked in various positions at the Moravian Business College Olomouc, in particular as Rector, Vice-Rector for Science and Research and associate professor at the Department of Economics and the Department of Sustainable Development.

Currently, she works at Palacky University, Faculty of Health Sciences, Centre for Science and Research. She is also Vice-Dean for International Relations and Internationalisation. In the field of bioeconomics, she is the leader of the Socio-Economic Section of the Platform for Bioeconomy (Czech Republic) and from March 2022 also a member of the Circular Bio-based Europe Joint Undertaking (CBE JU) Scientific Committee.

Her main areas of expertise are public economics, public finance, and the impact of financial and economic policy instruments. She is the author of a number of scientific articles and a monograph. She has lectured internationally at universities in Hungary (Budapest Business School), Germany (Hochschule Nordhausen, Duale Hochschule Villingen Schwenningen, Ruhr Universität Bochum), Slovenia (University of Maribor), the Netherlands (Utrecht University), Israel (Kinneret Academic College) and China (Dalian Minzu University).

Keynote Speakers





Michaela Bednárová

Associate prof. Ing. Michaela Bednárová, BA (Hons), PhD. currently holds a position as a faculty member at the Department of Financial Economics and Accounting at the University Pablo de Olavide in Seville, Spain. Her academic journey culminated in the successful completion of her Ph.D. in Management and Economics at the University of Huelva, Spain. She served as a visiting researcher at the esteemed Rutgers Business School of New Jersey in the

United States, the University of Economics in Bratislava, Slovakia and she was also a lecturer at the University of Edinburgh, UK. Her academic interests are multifaceted and encompass the realms of Digital Accounting, Stakeholder Engagement, Corporate Social Responsibility, Sustainability and Integrated Reporting, and more recently, the domain of Corporate Digital Responsibility. Dr. Bednárová's scholarly contributions have found their way into the pages of numerous international academic journals, including the International Journal of Accounting Information Systems, Meditari Accountancy Research, Government Information Quarterly (UK), Online Information Review (UK), Journal of Information Systems (USA), and the Spanish Accounting Review (Spain), to name a few. In recognition of her contributions, Dr. Bednárová was honored with the Emerald Literati Award in 2021 for her paper on the implications of Blockchain on accounting and auditing. Beyond academic journals, she also shares her expertise through contributions to professional journals, such as AECA, a publication of the Spanish Accounting Association (Spain). Furthermore, she has authored the book "Digital Disruption and Corporate Digital Responsibility" and co-authored four other books. Her dedication to the field extends to her editorial roles, as she serves as an Associate Editor for the International Journal of Digital Accounting Research, indexed in Scopus. She is also a member of various editorial boards, including Forum Scientiae Oeconomia, Journal of Contemporary Management (South Africa), and the Polish Journal of International Management. Dr. Bednárová consistently contributes her expertise as a peer reviewer for renowned international academic journals indexed in Web of Science (WOS) and Scopus. Dr. Bednárová's expertise is not confined to her publications; she has actively participated in numerous national and international research projects. Her involvement as an external quality expert in the Erasmus plus project "REPESEA - Assessing and Improving Research Performance at South East Asian Universities" and her engagement in the "CHAISE - Blockchain Skills for Europe" project underscore her commitment to advancing knowledge dissemination. She currently holds the role of local coordinator for the Erasmus plus Project "MASUDEM" (Master in Sustainable Development and Management), highlighting her dedication to education and sustainable development. In recognition of her expertise, Dr. Bednárová has assumed significant roles in professional organizations. She has been appointed as a member of the committee for new technologies in accounting at AECA (Madrid) and serves as a member of the Academic Advisory Body of INATBA (Brussels).
